Sunday School Spotlight

Nurturing Faith: 5-6 year-olds class

Mrs. Mary leads the 5-6-year-olds class at Woodlawn Baptist Church. She is a long-time member of the church and attends with her family. Each class begins with a prayer led by Mrs. Mary. Then, they dive into the lesson. While Mrs. Mary is teaching, the children are encouraged to use playdough to create something related to the lesson, ask questions, and engage with the material.

A special tradition in her class is the placement of the children's handprints on the wall. Each handprint represents a current or past class member and serves as a reminder of everyone who has passed through her class.

At this age, children often have many questions about God and their faith, especially as they start school and are exposed to more of the world outside of the church and their homes. Mrs. Mary's nurturing spirit, patience, and genuine care create a safe and welcoming environment where children are supported as they begin to understand God's love and purpose for their lives.

As a result of Mrs. Mary's teaching and guidance, each child carries with them the seeds of faith that she has planted. These seeds will continue to flourish and bear fruit as they grow in their walk with the Lord.
